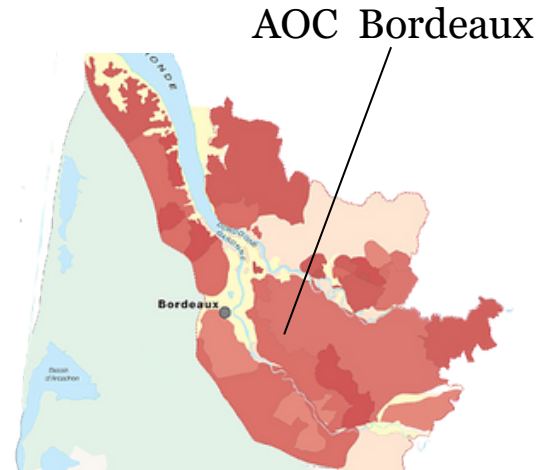


Château Julien

Located at the renowned Bordeaux appellation, where the terroir and soil is favourable to grapes growth. The unique geographical location of Château Julien provides its vineyard with plenty of sunlight while the soil provides it with enough nutrients for the grape development. Strict management is practiced, from grapes cultivation to selection of grapes, from vinification to aging, each step is carried out precisely in order to create a typical yet delicate Bordeaux wine.
